FELLOWSHIP

- Online Bible study on every Tuesdays as from 8 :00 pm to 9:00 Pm
- Silent Prayers on every Wednesday

WEDDINGS

We had two weddings this year; Paul Ombima from Sulmac local church and Cleany Biketi from Naivasha local church.

PROJECTS

- 1.Sulmac have built up a Sunday school and Teens Hall, they are also constructing two rental houses.
- 2.Naivasha local church is in process of completing the Sunday school and teens hall. They also intend to complete pastor's house, Offices and two rental houses.
- 3.A major Fundraising is scheduled for July 2024 on Sunday 14th.

4. Gilgil have completed the tilling of their church floor. They hope to raise funds and construct a nursery school and pastor's house .

CHALLENGES

1. Some members have not been tithing for various reasons.

2. Some flower companies which hires several of our members have closed down rendering them jobless.

3. Some nominated leaders did not take up their roles while others are not active at all.

4. We have new members who don't understand our Quaker Faith and practice. Others have not read the church constitutions.

5. The distance between our local churches makes it difficult and expensive during visitations by pastors and monthly meeting services.
